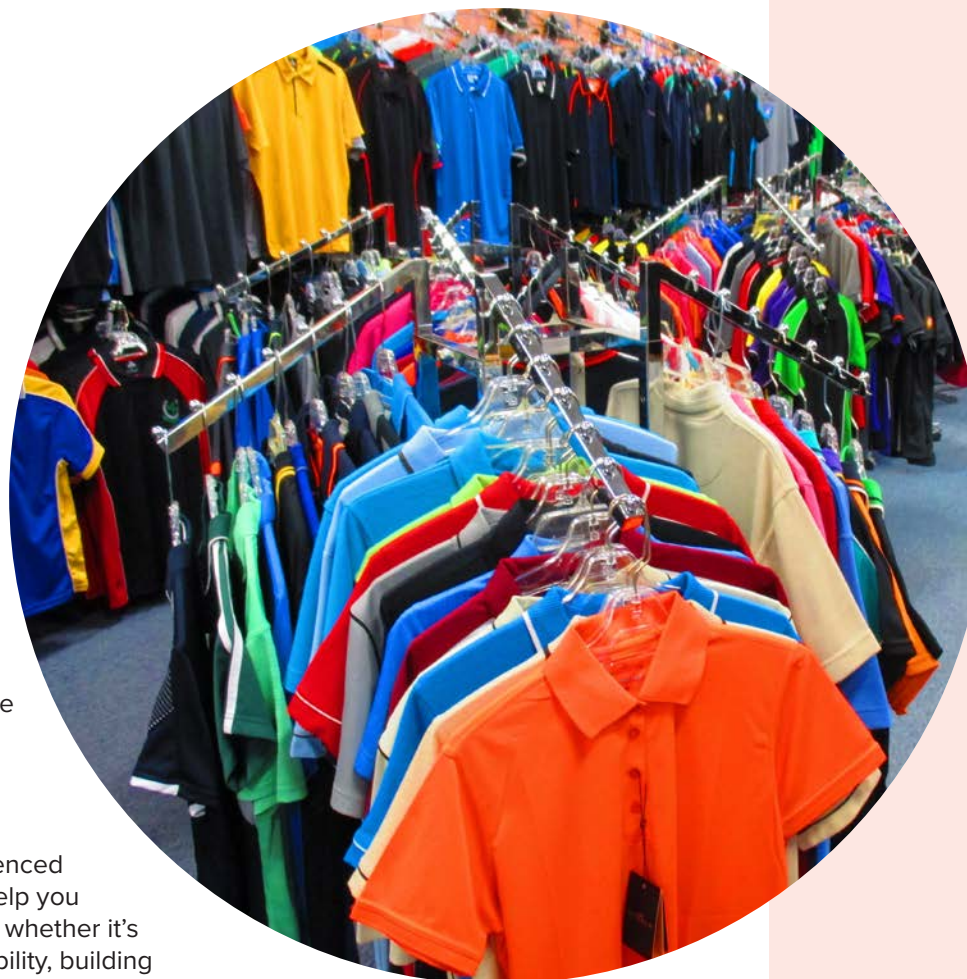

2. Pick styles and fabrics based on job roles and functions

SALES REPS & ACCOUNT MANAGERS

These client-facing roles should project professionalism and credibility to build trust and ease in clients. Think classic, well-fitted attire like suits, dress shirts and vests for men, and suits, business dresses or blouses for women.

Consider the dress code and culture of your workplace; some companies may have a more relaxed dress code.



MANAGEMENT & EXECUTIVES

Leadership roles should project professionalism and authority, and contribute to a positive and organised environment. Timeless, formal attire is suitable, such as suits, dress shirts, ties, and professional dresses for women. Colours can be more subdued, like navy, charcoal grey, and black.



FRONT DESK STAFF & EXECUTIVE ASSISTANTS

These roles require a polished and professional appearance. Opt for high-quality fabrics like wool, cotton or blends that convey professionalism and comfort. Adapt your attire accordingly with company culture, which may vary from formal to casual.



RETAIL ASSISTANTS

Dress codes will vary widely based on the type of store and target audience. Generally a professional and approachable style is appropriate. Think polos and shirts for casual brands to suits and dresses for high end brands.

Comfort should be a priority, as these roles often involve physical tasks and interaction with customers.

If your company has a specific theme or atmosphere, consider incorporating elements of that theme into your attire.



OPERATIONAL OFFICE ROLES

Positions like analysts, technicians, accountants, IT, human resources and more may not have a specific ‘uniform’, but presenting a polished and professional image is key. Dress codes may vary from relaxed to strictly formal attire.



LOGISTICS AND DELIVERY

These roles require uniforms that are easily identifiable to ensure the safety of all visitors and staff, on and offsite. For a cohesive and professional image, these uniforms should be branded. Check the security protocols at your workplace first, and ensure your uniforms meet regulatory requirements.



The most important thing is that your team’s uniforms are comfortable, distinctive, and consistent with brand guidelines.

3. Define your branding and choose an appropriate customisation for each uniform

Your uniform is a visual representation of your brand. It should align with your brand's colours, logo, and overall aesthetic to maintain consistency. A cohesive uniform reinforces a consistent, professional, and recognisable brand image.

DIRECT TO FILM HEAT TRANSFER

DTF is a revolutionary heat transfer printing method that offers a vibrant and super high-definition solution for branding t-shirts. It blends the best of vinyl heat transfer with screen printing.

- Unlimited, vibrant colours. Fine details are preserved.
- Environmentally friendly – uses water based inks, no PVC.

SCREEN PRINTING

Screen printing has long been a reliable and versatile branding method, despite newer and faster technologies now available. The process involves using stencils and multiple layers of ink to create detailed and long-lasting designs.



DYE SUBLIMATION

Dye sublimation uses heat to transfer dyes onto polyester fabric. The dyes turn into a gas, permeate the fabric, and solidify, creating vibrant, long-lasting prints with excellent colour accuracy and a smooth finish.

- Allows a full coverage of colours, gradients, and photographic images.
- Durable and resistant to fading, cracking, or peeling.
- Well-suited for intricate and complex designs.
- Suitable for small batches.



- Perfect for limited colour designs and well defined graphic elements.
- Thick ink creates excellent colour saturation and vibrancy, especially on dark fabrics.

VINYL HEAT TRANSFER

Vinyl heat transfer printing involves cutting a design from coloured vinyl and using a heat press to transfer it onto fabric. This process delivers a clean and lasting look with vibrant colours, making it ideal for smaller quantities and designs that require sharp details.

- Popular choice for team and sports uniforms – easy to customise numbers and names.
- Works on all coloured fabrics and odd surfaces like hats.



CASE STUDY

Creating a uniform for Turbomax



Turbomax Auto Parts is a leading Australian supplier of high-performance auto parts with a dedicated team of 120 employees.

Turbomax recognised the importance of a cohesive and professional image for their team. Their existing uniforms were outdated, lacked brand consistency, and did not reflect the company's commitment to innovation.

The challenge was to create a new uniform design that not only embodies the company's values but also provides functionality and comfort for the many roles within the organisation.

Using the primary palette colours of red, black and white, we created a flexible and cohesive uniform range that each department can adapt to their preferences and needs.



We used the Nitro polo as the base garment for its bold contrast panels and easy-care, durable pique fabric that feels great to wear all year round. It suits floor, warehouse, sales and admin staff.



Embroidered caps help protect staff from the elements and are useful as a branding tool.

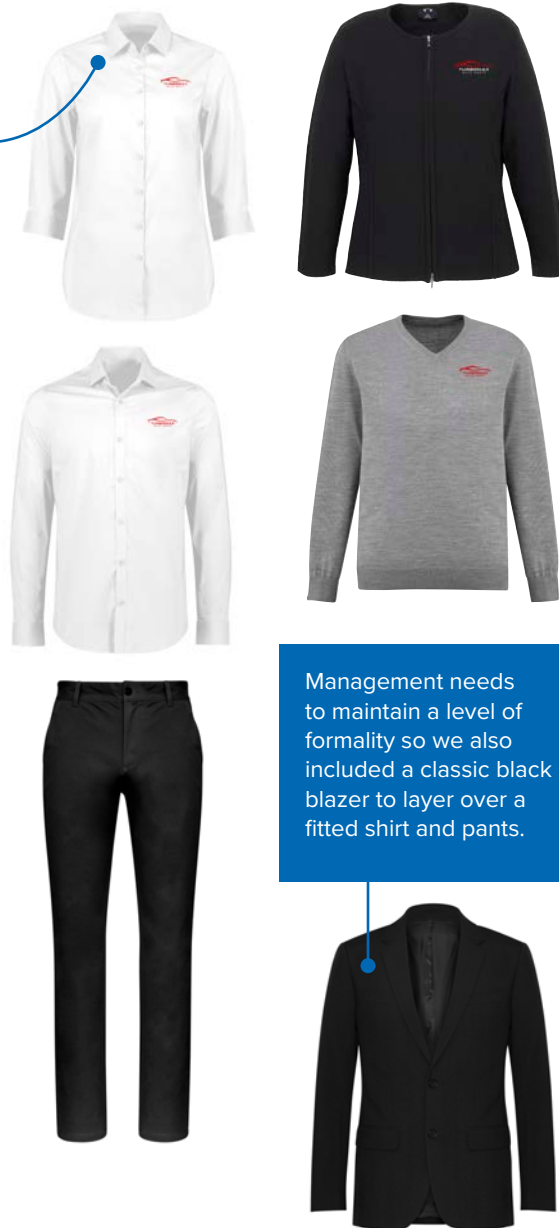


For layering in the trans-seasonal and colder months, we picked a soft shell jacket and vest – soft, warm, water repellent, breathable, and durable.



Admin staff are often the first point of contact onsite, so they needed professional uniforms that allow movement, comfort and style.

We picked tailored shirts and trans-seasonal knitwear, with an option for stretchy work skirts or pants.



For floor and warehouse staff we picked the Basic Stretch Cargo Pant as the bottom for superior freedom of movement and comfort.



The matching jacket in the Nitro range was an obvious wet weather jacket choice. Its durable exterior, micro-fleece lining, high collar and long length keeps staff warm and cosy when they need to be out in the elements.



Sales representatives are frequently on the road and are an important first touchpoint for a prospective client. The Nitro short sleeve shirt pairs perfectly with our bestselling Lawson chino pant, creating a down-to earth and approachable impression.

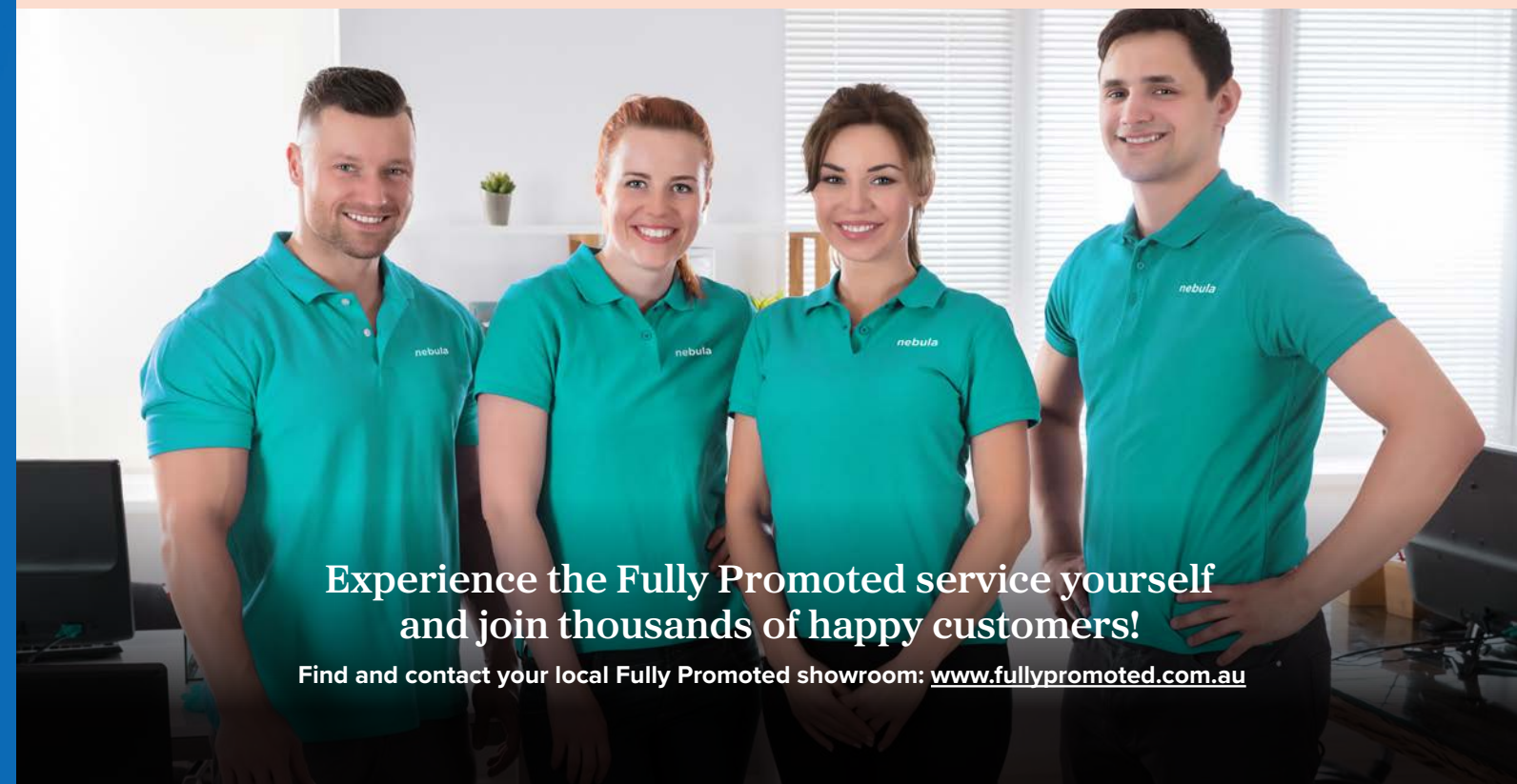
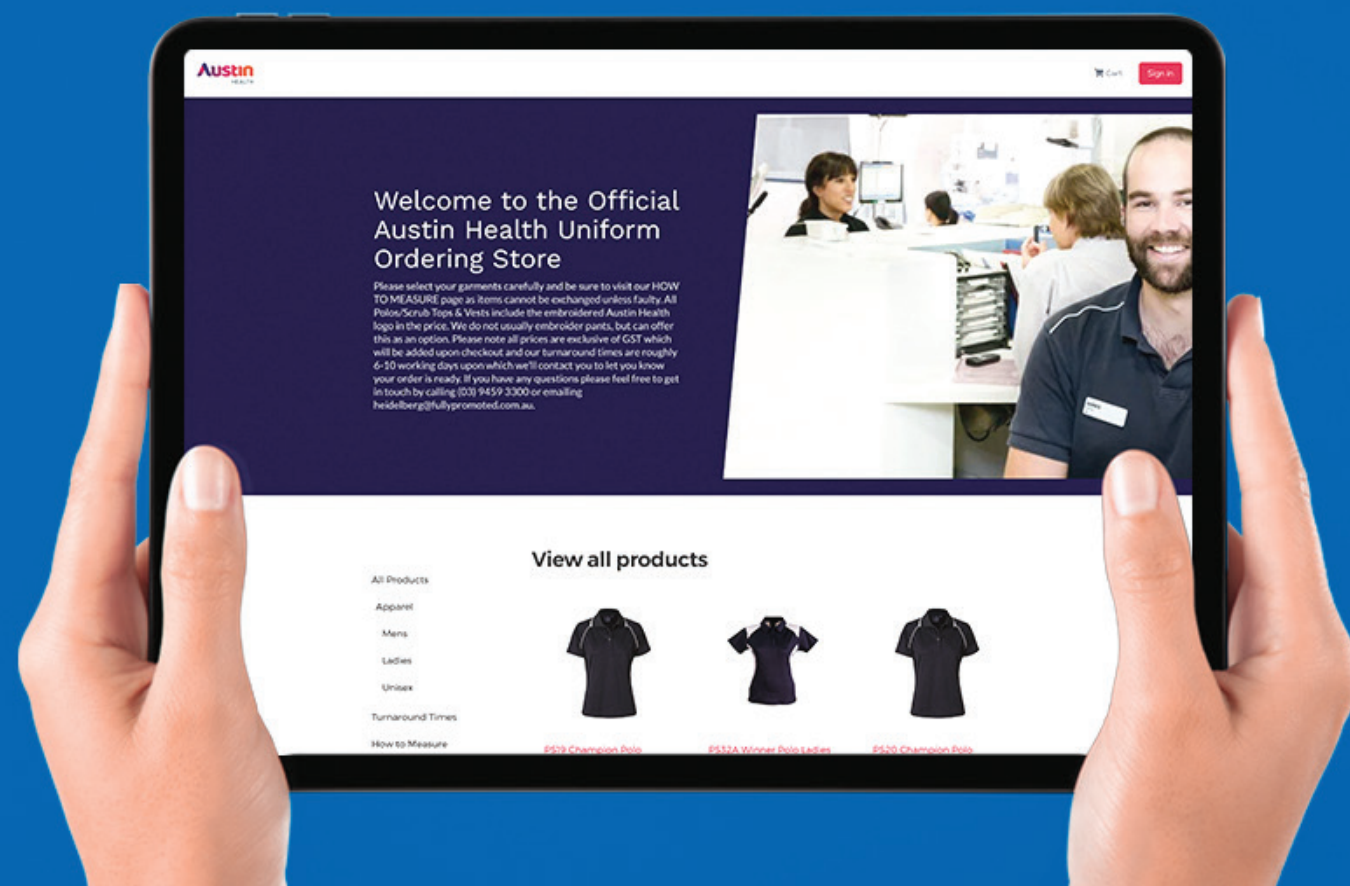
